BRONKHORSTSPRUIT OUTREACH

Weekly outreach at the clinic in Bronkhorstspuit

Alfredo's Soup Kitchen outreach team continues their heartfelt mission of service with their weekly outreach efforts at the clinic in Bronkhorstspuit. This week, Lana delivered a poignant message about the blood of Christ and its power to cleanse sins. The team served over 50 people with hot soup, bread, and the Gospel. Bheki installed four Bibles on patients' phones, Heleen gathered additional contact numbers for the Harvesters groups, and Christo shared the Gospel with approximately 25 people on the bus. Conversations with women from a drug rehab center revealed their willingness to assist homeless drug addicts from Short Street, (town outreach once a month). Plans were already underway for the next outreach on Saturday, 27th July, which will include soup, vetkoek (thanks to Tannie Magda), and the Gospel. The team extends their gratitude for everyone's assistance and prayers.

Last week the Alfredo's Soup Kitchen outreach team served over 50 people in the cold with hot soup, bread, and the Gospel. The message of that day, delivered by a team member, was about the rich ruler (Luke 18:18-23). Christo distributed Heart of Man tracts to people on the bus. Two homeless friends, Paul and James, joined the event and enjoyed the meal. The team requests prayers for these individuals. They extend their thanks and blessings to everyone involved. The Soup Kitchen had another successful outreach morning, serving over 50 people with soup and the Gospel. Approximately 20 people in the hospital bus also received the Gospel message. Bheki spoke on Romans 10:9-10, and the team prayed for everyone present, engaging in conversations about Jesus Christ and connecting with a few old saints. They gathered additional follow-up contact numbers for the Harvesters teams and installed a Bible on a phone. Unfortunately, there was no Bible study due to Sister Vanessa's illness, and the team asks for prayers for her healing. They express their heartfelt thanks and blessings to all supporters.

Monthly Town Outreach in Bronkhorstspuit

The same team from Alfredo's Soup Kitchen outreach undertakes a monthly town outreach besides their weekly endeavors to the clinic. This month it took place on Short Street, known for its homeless population and high criminal activity. The Gospel was well-received, reaching people struggling with drug issues, AIDS, and various challenges. Ten individuals dedicated their lives to Christ, and many others left with tracts supplied by EHCSA, the Gospel of John, and personal messages. The team also distributed sandwiches to the homeless, highlighting the significant need in the area. They call for prayers for more workers, referencing Matthew 9:37-38, and extend their gratitude to all who participated, acknowledging their dedication and obedience to the Lord's work.

The partnership with this team that is so dedicated to reaching out to people in their area, is cherished by EHCSA.

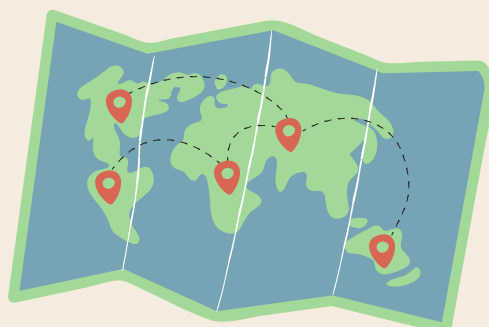

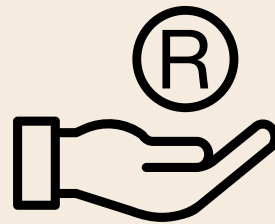
