Every Home South Africa partnered with Maranatha Church in Lakeside, under the leadership of Overseer Nhlapo, to fulfill our divine mandate. Together with Pastor Nkatlo and a passionate team of believers, we engaged in street ministry, home-to-home evangelism, and open-air evangelism, bringing the love of Christ to those who may never step into a church. As we walked the streets, we encountered both opposition and openness, a reminder of Jesus' words in Matthew 10:22: "You will be hated by everyone because of me, but the one who stands firm to the end will be saved."

One particularly moving encounter was with a man overcome by anger and pain. Standing outside a corner shop with a drink in hand, he lashed out at our team, expressing his deep resentment towards the Church due to a past wound. Instead of responding with fear, we stood firm in love, recognizing that his hostility came from a place of brokenness. We prayed for his healing, trusting that God's grace can restore even the most wounded hearts. Throughout the day, we witnessed lives being transformed by the Gospel. Among the many who responded was an elderly man who stood firm in prayer despite his wife's protests. His quiet determination reflected the work of the Holy Spirit moving in hearts.

A particularly powerful moment came at the end of the outreach when a man who had been listening from a distance, holding a Castle Lite beer, stepped forward, lifted his hands, and surrendered to Jesus. It was a beautiful reminder that no one is beyond God's reach—His love calls to each of us, no matter where we are.

We are committed to taking the Church to the people, ensuring that every home and individual has the opportunity to hear and respond to the message of salvation. If they cannot come to us, we will go to them. Let's continue to pray for those who are hurting, that they may find healing in Christ. And let's keep standing firm in our mission—to reach every home with the life-changing power of the Gospel.

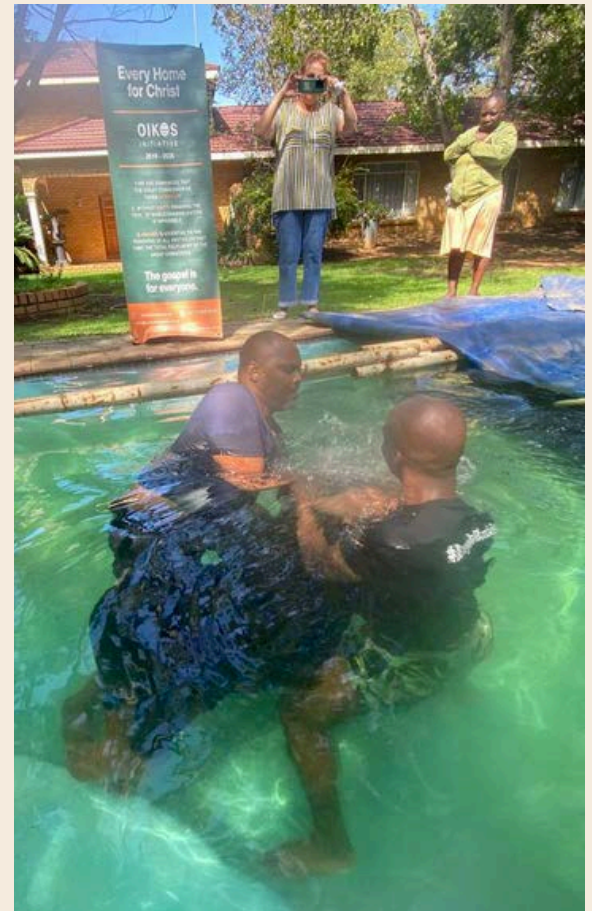
The Power of Baptism: A New Life in Christ

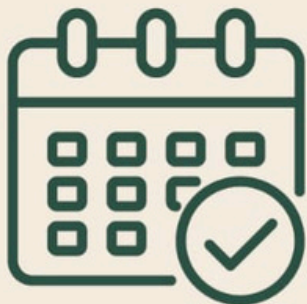

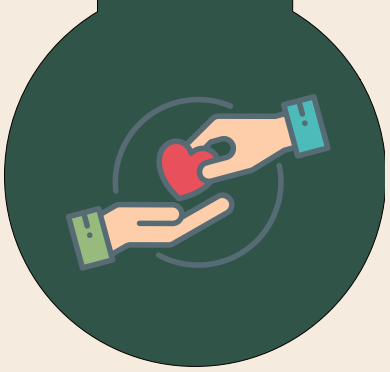

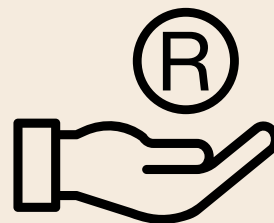
