The outreach was held in Phelindaba Extension 19, Atteridgeville, a vibrant community situated west of Pretoria.

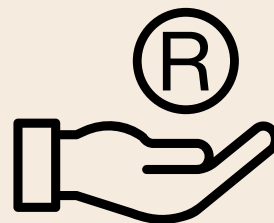
